New Business:

1. Community (Diversity & Inclusion) Calendar



- a. June is really busy with events/notable dates; National Indigenous Peoples Day/week and Pride Week often fall within the same week, causing some complications.
 - i. Can't change the dates as most are national or international.
 - ii. Focusing on Allyship so we can support all communities, rather than just choosing one.
- LDIA is not looking to plan any events; just need to determine what kind of messaging to put out there to support the different communities to avoid competing interests.
 - i. Lots of events that we won't be able to participate in this summer; need to refocus.
- c. Laura mentioned that LDIA and LIP should work together with this.
- d. Can't really plan events right now because of COVID-19.
- e. Virtual recognition event on June 27th? Something fun that kids can participate in?
- f. Should find out what events are going on and share on social media/website.
- g. LDIA members/community could create videos/etc. to find ways to connect with the community (i.e. cooking classes, virtual art, etc.).
- h. Will need to add a notable dates calendar to the website and attach links for information if possible; what kind of boundaries do we want to have? Need to be careful about boundaries because it can become exclusionary.
 - i. Missing some notable dates.
 Action Tymm to send an Excel spreadsheet.
 - ii. Can also look at the Multicultural Centre calendar.
 - iii. Can look at just linking different calendars to ours (interfaith, LIP, etc.)
- i. There is a conversation happening within the City to look at how to amalgamate all community calendars.
- j. City of Lethbridge now has a Diversity webpage and Tymm is going to put a link to LDIA on it.
- k. August LnL ideas: Youth? What is ageism from a youth and elder perspective; connect with Amnesty International to possibly host a writing campaign.
- I. December: John Humphrey periodic review training session by Tymm?
 - i. Host a series of events.
- m. Conversation around the word "tolerance" in the Day of Tolerance in November.
 - i. **Action** Discuss if we keep it on the calendar?
 - ii. The explanation of the day demonstrates importance of today, but the title is not appropriate.
 - iii. **Action** write a letter to the UN to consider changing the language of tolerance to something less oppressive and reflective of the intent of the day.
- n. **Action** standing item on the agenda to have a conversation around planning for activities of upcoming months.
